

Chamber Accreditation Council of Canada SIZE CATEGORIES: ACCREDITATION

In order to determine the category your Chamber falls under, please look at the qualities under each heading and be aware that it is necessary to only have **ONE** of the qualities listed in order to be considered for the size category. For example to be classified as a 'Small Chamber' the Chamber must either have up to 25,000 people and/or 0-100 members and/or up to \$100,000 in Chamber revenues.

If you possess qualities of two of the size categories it is your choice as to which you apply for, however we suggest you apply for the larger of the two categories. For example, if your Chamber has 75 members (small chamber category) but the Chamber revenues are \$125,000 (medium chamber category); you can either apply for a small or medium Chamber.

Small Chambers:

Small chambers possess one or all of the following qualities

Population of Service Area:	Up to 25,000 people
Number of chamber members:	0-100 members
Total chamber revenues:	Up to \$100,000

Medium Chambers:

Medium chambers possess one of all of the following qualities

Population of Service Area:	25, 001 to 75, 000
Number of chamber members:	101-500
Total chamber revenues:	\$100,001 - \$500,000

Large Chambers:

Large chambers possess one of all of the following qualities

Population of Service Area:	Greater than 75,001
Number of chamber members:	Greater than 500
Total chamber revenues:	Greater than \$500,000
